Hillsboro Police Department Welcomes New Officer



Officer Edward A. Ramirez graduated from University High School in Waco TX and left the next day for Marine Corps. Boot Camp. After completion of his basic training, he was trained as an Infantryman at the School of Infantry, Camp Pendleton, Ca. Ramirez was stationed at 29 Palms California with 3bn 7th Marines and deployed to Iraq in 2004. Upon return from Iraq Ramirez took a position with the 3/7 Family Readiness Office as a Casualty Tracker and later moved to 7th Marine Regiment where he tracked all casualties for the Regiment and 4 Battallions. Officer Ramirez returned to Waco in 2007 where he worked for a private security company for 1 year before taking a position as manager at Skatecountry in Bellmead, Tx. Officer Ramirez has always had a love for Law Enforcement and Community Service and decided to pursue that career in 2009 when he applied for the McLennan Community College Law Enforcement Academy. Officer Ramirez graduated as Class President in June 2009 and took a position as a Patrol Officer at Baylor University that same month.
