## Garbage, Recycle, Brush Collection



Allied Waste Services of Itasca in partnership with the City of Hillsboro is proud to announce the following collection initiatives in our continued efforts to keep Hillsboro clean. Effective Monday, October 6, 2008:

- Up to 6 cubic yards of brush will be collected once a month (\*\*see Brush Collection Map on the back of this flyer for your week of collection).
- Recycle bins will be collected the same day as your garbage (\*\*see Garbage Recycle Collection Map on the back of this flyer for your day of collection).

### Brush Collection Do's and Don'ts

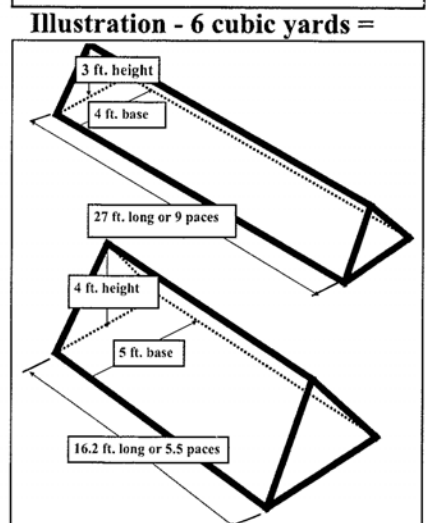
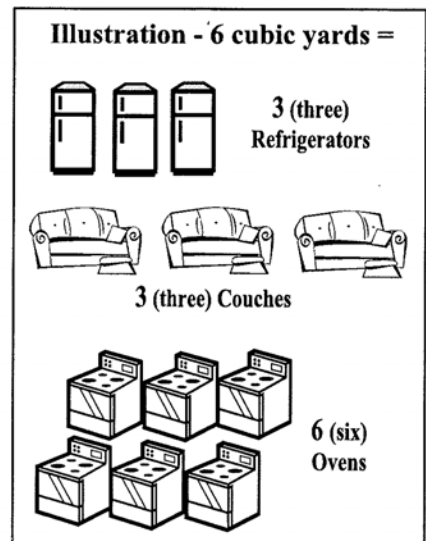
- *Do* place up to 6 cubic yards at curbside on the first, second, third, or fourth Monday of the month on your collection week. (See Brush Collection Map for your week and Illustrations 1 & 2 of 6 cubic yards)
- *Don't* place brush at curb in excess of 6 cubic yards or before your assigned week. Piles in excess of 6 cubic yards will be assessed \$65 for each 6 cubic yards above the initial 6 with a minimum charge of \$65. Brush collected in other than assigned week will also be charged a minimum of \$65.
- *Do* cut and bundle your brush to prepare for collection.
- *Don't* have bundles in excess of 4 feet in length with limbs of greater than 4 inches in diameter. Do not exceed 50 lbs per bundle.
- *Do* place your brush near the curb in front of your house on assigned week.
- *Don't* place your brush in front of another residence or on a vacant lot. This may result in enforcement penalties.
- *Don't* allow professional trimmers to charge you for service then place the limbs at the curb. Have them dispose of the limbs they cut.
- *Do* remember for brush in excess of 6 cubic yards or brush you need to clear on week other than that scheduled, you have free landfill privileges at Itasca Landfill on the first Saturday of each month. Please bring a current water bill and I.D.
- *Don't* mix construction debris with the brush. Free disposal day at the landfill is the best way to discard.

### Recycle Do's and Don'ts

- *Don't* place recycle tub at curb any later than 7:00 a.m. on your garbage collection day.
- *Do* recycle paper, magazines, telephone books, aluminum and steel cans, plastic bottles, broken down cardboard that will fit in your tub and plastic containers #1-7.
- *Don't* recycle styrofoam, foodwrap, tissue products, plastic bags, or glass.
- *Do* rinse all bottles and cans and contain any blowing recyclables in a paper grocery bag within the tub.

### Garbage Do's and Don'ts

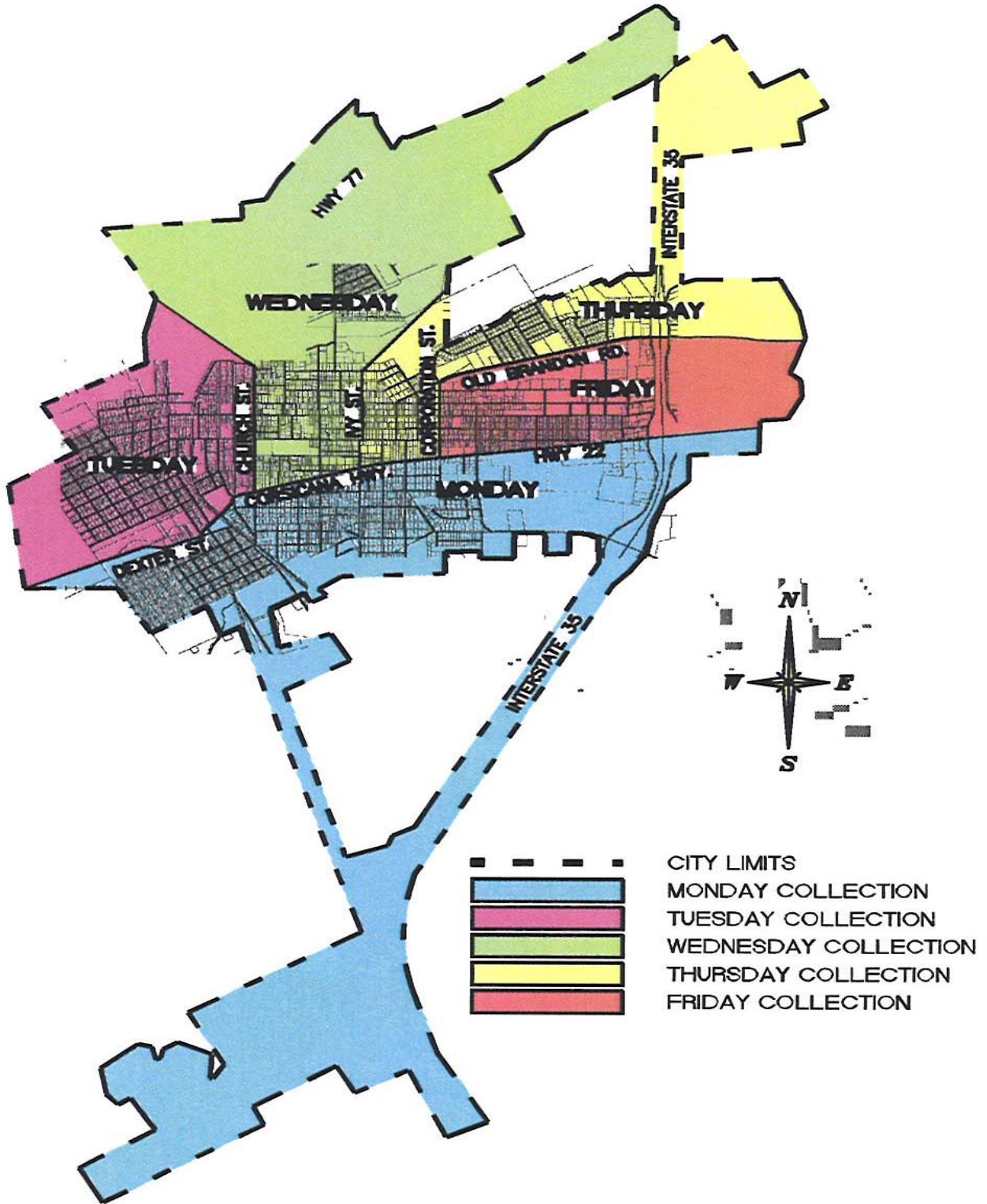
- *Do* have at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your assigned collection day (see Garbage/Recycle Collection Map)
- *Don't* place broken glass, syringes, or other sharp objects in plastic bags.
- *Do* use boxes or milk cartons to place broken glass, syringes or sharp objects in.
- *Don't* pile loose garbage at curbside.
- *Do* bag all garbage to keep from blowing as this helps keeps Hillsboro Beautiful.
