BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT – Hill County

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has begun a project to replace three county-road bridges in Hill County.

The existing wooden and steel girder structures on, Hill County Road 3363 @ the Navasota River (Northeast of Mt Calm), Hill County Road 3102 @ Two Mile Tributary (South of Hillsboro and Hill County Road 3441 @ Four Mile Creek (North of Malone) are being replaced with wider concrete and steel bridges that meet current roadway safety and design specifications. The approaches to the bridges will be upgraded as well.

The project began April 4 and will temporarily close the three roadways to thru traffic during bridge construction.

Big Creek Construction of Hewitt is undertaking these off-system bridge replacement projects at a cost of approximately \$673,000. The three bridge replacement projects are tentatively scheduled for completion by the late winter of this year, weather permitting.

TxDOT asks that motorists seek alternate routes and cautions local residents to observe all warning signs and to be aware of construction personnel and equipment in the work area.
