**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 8, 2010, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE COUNCILMEMBER FOR PLACE 2, FROM PRECINCT NUMBER TWO; ONE COUNCILMEMBER FOR PLACE 4, FROM PRECINCT NUMBER FOUR; AND ONE COUNCILMEMBER FOR PLACE 6, ELECTED AT LARGE, ALL PRECINCTS FOR REGULAR TWO YEAR TERMS; DESIGNATING THE CITY SECRETARY AS THE EARLY VOTING CLERK; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING; ESTABLISHING LOCATION, DAYS AND TIMES FOR EARLY VOTING TO BE CONDUCTED AND ESTABLISHING THE LOCATION, DAY AND TIME WHERE ELECTION DAY WILL BE CONDUCTED; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF DIRECT RECORDING ELECTRONIC VOTING MACHINES; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSIONS TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, TEXAS**

**Section 1.** That the municipal election is hereby ordered to be held on the 8th day of May, 2010 for the purpose of electing three Councilmembers:

- One (1) Councilmember, Place 2, Precinct #2
- One (1) Councilmember, Place 4, Precinct #4
- One (1) Councilmember, Place 6, Elected at Large

**Section 2.** Karen S. Warren, the City Secretary, shall serve as Early Voting Clerk. Ms. Warren's official mailing address is:

Applications for ballots by mail shall be mailed to Karen S. Warren at the address set out above. Applications for ballot by mail must be received no later than the close of business on Friday, April 30, 2010.

**Section 3.** Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted beginning April 26, 2010 and continuing through May 4, 2010 at the following location in the City of Hillsboro. A voter entitled to vote an early ballot by personal appearance may vote at the following location:

- (a) Early Voting Polling Place:
  - Hillsboro City Administration Building
  - 214 E. Elm Street
  - Hillsboro, Texas 76645
- (b) Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the above location on the following dates and times:

Apr. 26 – Apr. 28 (Mon.- Wed.)	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Apr 29 (Thursday)	8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.
Apr 30 (Friday)	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
May 3 (Monday)	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

May 4 (Tuesday)

8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.

**Section 4.** Election Day Central Polling Place:  
(a) Hillsboro Junior High School Gym  
210 E. Walnut Street  
Hillsboro, Texas 76645

(b) May 8, 2010 (Saturday) 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

**Section 5.** The City Secretary is directed to provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling location in accordance with Section 16.012 of the Texas Election Code. The system must comply with state and federal laws setting the requirements for voting systems that permit voters with physical disabilities to cast a secret ballot. The Office of the Texas Secretary of State has certified that the E S & S IvoTronic ADA Terminals, Version 9.1.6.2 which will be provided through an agreement with Hill County Elections Office and is an accessible voting system that may be legally be used in Texas elections.


**Section 6.** The Mayor is authorized to sign an Order of Election, notice of which shall be given in both English and Spanish, shall be posted on the bulletin board at the City Administration Building of the City used for posting of notices of meetings of the City Council of the City and at three (3) other public places within the City not later than the twenty-first (21<sup>st</sup>) day prior to the date upon which said election is to be held; and shall be published in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and the City Charter. The Order of Election is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**Section 7.** The City Secretary, City of Hillsboro, is hereby responsible for any necessary submissions to the U. S. Department of Justice for pre clearance of said election under the Federal Voting Rights Act.


**Section 8.** Should any part, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution be held to be unconstitutional or of no force and effect, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this resolution, but in all respects said remaining portion shall be and remain in full force and effect.

**Section 9.** That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.




