Registration begins May 31st in the Children's Library. Pick up reading logs!

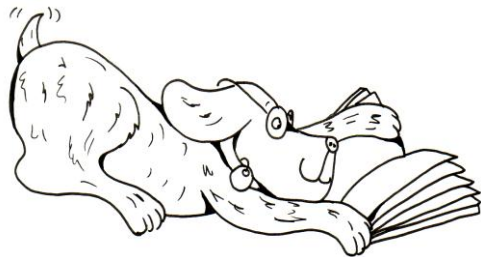
Read library books on your reading level.
