


How to View and Search the Historic Survey for National Register of Historic Places.

When you click on the Historic Survey for National Register of Historic Places link on the Hillsboro Website, you might notice a delay while the document loads. This is a very big document that could take longer than usual to open depending on your Internet Service Provider, web browser of choice, and internet connection speed.

When the document opens, it will open in your web browser or in a PDF viewing program like Adobe Reader. Below we have listed a few ways to search the document. Searching will allow you to look for specific street names or address numbers instead of looking through all 893 pages. Below we have outlined how to search the document when using: Chrome, Internet Explorer, FireFox, Adobe Reader, and a Quick Key that will also work with all four.


Chrome Web Browser

In the top right corner, you will see an icon with three horizontal bars. Click on it and you will see a menu drop down. Click on the Find... option and a text box will open. Just type in your search word and Chrome will highlight that word for you in the document.




Firefox Web Browser

In the top right corner, you will see an icon with three horizontal bars. Click on it and you will see a menu drop down. Click on the Find... option and a text box will open. Just type in your search word and Firefox will highlight that word for you in the document.




Internet Explorer Web Browser

On the top menu bar, click on Edit. In the drop down menu box, click on the Find option. A text box will open. Just type in your search word and Internet Explorer will highlight that word for you in the document.



Adobe Reader PDF Program

If the document opens in the Adobe program, then click on the Edit button at the top and then click on the Find option. A text box will open. Just type in your search word and Adobe Reader will highlight that word for you in the document.



Quick Key Method

On your keyboard, you can press the CTRL and F keys at the same time to quickly open the Find feature. This is the easiest method if you cannot see the menu bars like pictured above.
