

Food For Families Food Drive

"Food for Families" is an annual one-day food drive held each year to collect non-perishable food items and stock the shelves of area food banks and pantries beyond the holiday season. This annual event will be held the Friday before Thanksgiving, November 18. Donations are collected locally at the Scout Hut, located on Corsicana Highway next to Christ Lutheran Church. Donations collected in Hillsboro go directly to the food pantry at Hillsboro Interfaith Ministries (HIM) and are used to



stock the shelves at the food pantry to meet the ongoing needs of people in Hillsboro and other communities served by HIM. Monetary donations are especially desired because the HIM food pantry is small and does not have the space for storage or warehousing of surplus food products. Monetary donations may be mailed to Hillsboro Food for Families, P.O. Box 793, Hillsboro, Texas 76645. Be sure to make checks payable to HIM with "Food for Families" written on the memo line.
