#### **Invitation for Bids**

The City of Hillsboro, hereinafter “City” or “Grant Recipient” will receive bids for the Johns Manville Drive Extension until 2:00pm on Wednesday, March 10, 2021 at the City of Hillsboro Purchasing Office, 214 E. Elm Street, Hillsboro, TX 76645. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00pm on Wednesday, March 10, 2021 at the City of Hillsboro Purchasing Office, 214 E. Elm Street, Hillsboro, TX 76645.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

1. Approximately 1,900 linear feet of PVC sanitary sewer improvements including manholes.
2. Approximately 800 linear feet of PVC water improvements including gate valves and hydrants.
3. Approximately 450 linear feet of RCP storm water improvements including manholes, inlets, and structures.
4. Approximately 3,700 square yards of reinforced concrete pavement including embankment and subgrade preparation.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Hillsboro or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

The City of Hillsboro reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by City of Hillsboro for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder’s qualifications prior to the contract award.
