Resolution No. R2019-02-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 4, 2019, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MAYOR, ELECTED AT LARGE, THREE CITY COUNCILMEMBERS, ONE FOR PLACE 1, FROM PRECINCT NUMBER ONE; ONE COUNCILMEMBER FOR PLACE 3, FROM PRECINCT NUMBER THREE; AND ONE COUNCILMEMBER FOR PLACE 5, FROM PRECINCT NUMBER FIVE, ALL PRECINCTS FOR REGULAR TWO YEAR TERMS; DESIGNATING THE CITY SECRETARY AS THE EARLY VOTING CLERK; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING; ESTABLISHING LOCATION, DAYS AND TIMES FOR EARLY VOTING TO BE CONDUCTED; DESIGNATING WHERE APPLICATIONS FOR BALLOT BY MAIL SHOULD BE MAILED AND ESTABLISHING THE LOCATION, DAY AND TIME WHERE ELECTION DAY WILL BE CONDUCTED; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF DIRECT RECORDING ELECTRONIC VOTING MACHINES; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR UPDATED RULES REGARDING SUBMISSIONS TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, TEXAS

**Section 1.** That the municipal election is hereby ordered to be held on the 4th day of May, 2019 for the purpose of electing a Mayor and three Councilmembers:

- Mayor, Elected at Large
- One (1) Councilmember, Place 1, Precinct #1
- One (1) Councilmember, Place 3, Precinct #3
- One (1) Councilmember, Place 5, Precinct #5

**Section 2.** Karen S. Warren, the City Secretary, shall serve as Early Voting Clerk. Ms. Warren's official mailing address is:

Applications for ballots by mail shall be mailed to Karen S. Warren at the address set out above or scanned with an original signature and emailed to [kwarren@hillsborotx.org](mailto:kwarren@hillsborotx.org) Applications for ballot by mail must be received no later than the close of business at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 2019.

**Section 3.** Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted beginning April 22, 2019 and continuing through April 30, 2019 at the following location in the City of Hillsboro. A voter entitled to vote an early ballot by personal appearance may vote at the following location:

- (a) Early Voting Polling Place:
  - Historic City Hall
  - 127 E. Franklin Street
  - Hillsboro, Texas 76645

- (b) Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the above location on the following dates and times:

Apr. 22 – Apr. 24 (Mon. - Wed.)	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Apr. 25 (Thursday)	8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.
Apr. 26 (Friday)	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Apr. 29 (Monday)	8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.
Apr. 30 (Tuesday)	8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

**Section 4.** Election Day Central Polling Place:

- (a) Historic City Hall  
127 E. Franklin Street  
Hillsboro, Texas 76645

- (b) May 4, 2019 (Saturday) 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

**Section 5.** The City Secretary is directed to provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling location in accordance with Section 504 of the Federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Federal Americans With Disabilities Act; and provide a practical and effective means for voters with physical disabilities to cast a secret ballot. The Office of the Texas Secretary of State has certified that the iVotronic Image Manager ADA Terminals, Version 2.0.1.0 which will be provided through an agreement with Hill County Elections Office, is an accessible voting system that may be legally used in Texas elections.

**Section 6.** The Mayor is authorized to sign an Order of Election, notice of which shall be given in both English and Spanish, shall be posted on the bulletin board at the City Administration Building of the City, used for posting of notices of meetings of the City Council and at three (3) other public places within the City not later than the twenty-first (21<sup>st</sup>) day prior to the date upon which said election is to be held and remain posted through election day; and shall be published in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and the City Charter. The Order of Election is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".


**Section 7.** The City Secretary is no longer required or responsible for submissions to the U. S. Department of Justice for preclearance(s) in regards to elections. "Jurisdictions identified by the coverage formula in Section 4(b) of the Voting Rights Act, no longer need to seek preclearance for new voting changes, unless they are covered by a separate court order entered under Section 3(c) of the Voting Rights Act."


**Section 8.** Should any part, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution be held to be unconstitutional or of no force and effect, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this resolution, but in all respects said remaining portion shall be and remain in full force and effect.

**Section 9.** That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
